350 - STUDENT BEHAVIOUR AND CONDUCT

Background

Wild Rose School Division supports its staff in the maintenance of proper order and discipline to promote and maintain a safe and caring school environment.

Procedures

1. Each school, with input from staff, students, parents, and the school council, will develop a discipline plan.
2. Parents and students must be made aware of the discipline plan at the beginning of the school year or term, including their role and responsibilities.
3. Suspension and expulsion of pupils will be in accordance with Section 24 of the School Act.
4. In cases of persistent unacceptable behaviour, a referral for educational/ psychological assessment, family counselling or to community or government agencies should be considered.
