

441 - VISITORS TO THE SCHOOL

Background

Parents and visitors are welcome in the schools and classrooms of the Division. However, it is recognized that, under certain circumstances, such visitations may cause disruption to students and classroom routines. They are therefore permitted under the following conditions.

Procedures

1. In addition to parent-teacher interviews or open-house situations, visitors are permitted in classrooms during instruction time only with prior approval of the Principal and teacher.
2. Parents or other visitors are encouraged to make appointments at least one day ahead of time with the Principal and teacher to visit classrooms during instructional periods, stating their reason for doing so.
3. In the event a visitation request is refused, an appeal may be made to the Superintendent.
