

542 - DISASTER SERVICES

Background

The Division accepts its responsibility as a public organization to participate with municipal authorities in the provision of emergency services during times of disaster.

It further recognizes that Municipal Authorities, through their Disaster Services Committees, may require Division controlled facilities, equipment, and personnel in order to fulfill the Agency's commitments to the communities served.

Therefore, the Division is prepared to allow the use of its resources during an emergency with the understanding that all associated costs will be borne by the appropriate municipal authorities.

Procedures

1. The Superintendent designates the Transportation Supervisor/or designate as the official coordinator of disaster services for the School Division.
