Full Day, Every Day Kindergarten

The Board rescinded motion 161/12 and moved that the full-day every-day Kindergarten pilot program in Drayton Valley be extended for a second year (2013-2014), that additional space be provided as required, and that a monthly per child fee be levied to recover the additional unfunded costs associated with operating such a program. In addition, the Superintendent will conduct a further study of the expansion of such a program to communities outside of Drayton Valley, and bring forward a recommendation to the April, 2013 Board Meeting.
