- 1. Bill Snyder, Penni Lougheed, Sarah Koenig and two students spoke on the charitable and learning projects going on at École Rocky Elementary. These projects utilize SMART Learning tools and are part of a sequence called "Junk Yard Wonders."
- 2. Kristen Collison and students from Caroline School shared with the Board about their work on SPEAK. SPEAK is a program that works to make the Caroline School a more empathetic, socially minded and progressive environment. Its goal is to make Caroline School a place where students show daily how to accept the differences of others.
- 3. Ryan Smith and students from Leslieville School shared about their work on the Leslieville Rink Restoration. The rink, located on school grounds, has been in dire need of repair.
